Doctor: Right. Please sit here, now can you take a deep breath? Okay, and another. Good, now can you open your mouth and say "ahh?" Okay, good. Now, I'm going to take your temperature. Please put this thermometer under your arm. Thank you.

Doctor: It's quite close. Go out of the clinic and turn left. Go straight for about 200 meters, then turn left at the library. Go through the tunnel and the pharmacy is on your right. It's next to the bank.

Sue: Thanks. I'll go there now. Do I need to make another appointment?

Doctor: No, making another appointment isn't necessary. But it is very important that you get plenty of sleep. After you go to the pharmacy, you should go home and go to bed.

Sue: Okay doctor, I'll do that.
