First, there are two pizza shops in my town, Pizza Primo and Italiana. I have a coupon for Italiana, so I can get a discount, but they don't deliver, they only do pick-up. I'm not going to walk all the way down to their shop, it's too far. I think I'm going to order a pizza from Pizza Primo and get it delivered.

Next, the crust. Pizza Primo has three types of crust. Crispy, regular and Chicago style. Regular is thicker than crispy, and Chicago is the thickest of all. Crispy is too thin for me, and regular isn't thick enough. I think I might order a Chicago style crust.

Now, the toppings. Pizza Primo has two kinds of sauce, regular tomato and spicy chili. I like spicy food, but the spicy chili is too spicy! I'll order the regular tomato. I like lots of meat on my pizza. Pizza Primo does three different meat pizzas, the Primo Meat Deluxe, the Meat Explosion, and the Salami Surprise.

The Primo Meat Deluxe has sausage, beef, onions, olives and cheese. A regular size costs \$50 and a large size costs \$65. It's way too expensive! I don't have enough money to get a Primo Meat Deluxe.

The Meat Explosion has ham, bacon, chicken, pepperoni, beef and sausage. I like meat pizza, but that is way too much meat! I couldn't finish even a regular sized Meat Explosion. My friends and I ordered one of this a few weeks ago and it took 3 people to finish off a regular size pizza. There was just so much meat on it. It was really filling.

The Salami Surprise comes with salami, onions, olives, and anchovies. I like salami and onions, and I love olives, but I don't like anchovies. There is enough meat on this pizza for me. I think I will order a Salami Surprise but without the anchovies and with extra olives.
