<u>To listen to music</u> just select "Music" on the remote and the whole library should pop up. Then, to choose a song all you have to do is scroll and click "Enter."

Watching movies or TV shows is just as easy. Just press "movies" or "TV shows" on the remote and then you will be able to access them.

Before I bought my new system, I had so many remotes - maybe 11 or 12. It was really annoying shuffling through the different remotes until I found the one I was looking for. That's why I decided to spend the extra money, and get a universal remote this time.

It takes a little time to learn how to use it, but once you can use it, it's so much better.
